



CONSTRUCTION NOTICE - NOVEMBER 2022

2022 CIPP REHABILITATION PROJECT

The South Valley Sewer District is conducting sewer pipeline rehabilitation along the Jordan River Trail beginning as early as November 7, 2022.

PROJECT BACKGROUND

South Valley Sewer District (District) is cleaning and repairing various segments of aging sewer infrastructure in Riverton and South Jordan. The District has found that these sewer pipes are in poor condition and in need of repairs to prevent additional deterioration and operational impacts. This project is using innovative technology to install a liner inside the existing pipe. This installation will take place while the old sewer line is still in service, which will minimize the impact to the public. Liner installation and re-establishing customer service connections may require some minimal excavation work.

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

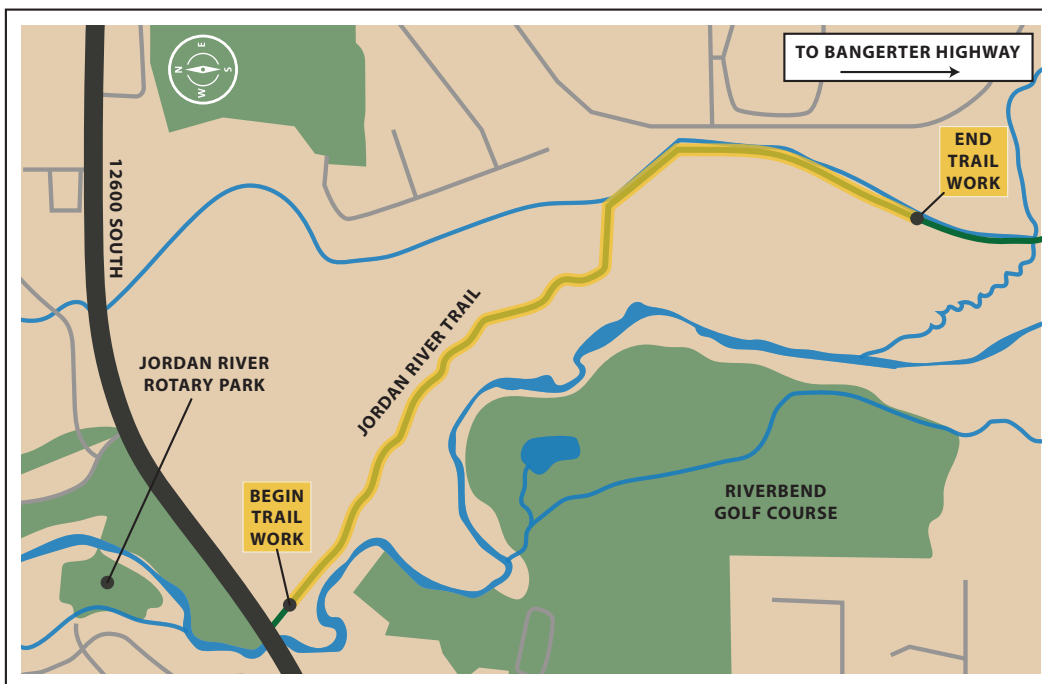
Crews will be conducting sewer pipeline rehabilitation along the Jordan River Trail between in the section of trail between 12300 South and Bangerter Highway beginning as early as November 7, 2022.

Construction will occur off the trail and will require the shoulder on the west side of the trail to be closed. This work will occur between 7:00 am - 7:00 pm, including work on weekends.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- Temporary increase in noise and odors
- Temporary trail access closures and detours
- Crossing steel plates over trenches where bypasses are being installed to maintain flow.

Construction is anticipated to take up to 4 weeks.
